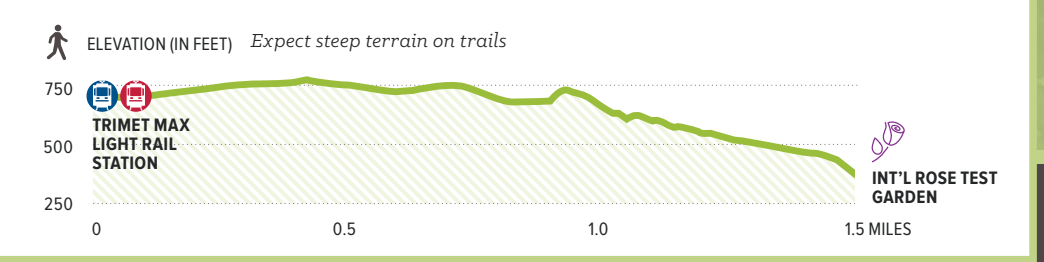

Park Rules

- Dogs must be on leash.
- All parks and natural areas are smoke and tobacco free.
- Alcohol at permitted events only.

Park hours: 5 a.m. – 10 p.m.

Park Tips

- Use TriMet (bus or light rail) to get to the park. Adult fare is \$2.50 for a 2.5-hour ticket or \$5.00 for a day pass. Children under 7 ride for free.

- 63** Use TriMet's Line 63 bus to get from MAX light rail (either Washington Park station or Kings Hill station) to the gardens.
- P** Use the Parking Kitty app to pay for parking with your mobile device. See parking information (other side).
- Use the Kings Hill MAX station to walk up hill to the gardens.
- Do not leave valuables in your car.
